Set in 16 acres of grounds overlooking the River Severn, Cygnnet Lodge Kewstoke is a high support inpatient rehabilitation (level 2) service for men who have enduring mental illness and may have been detained under the Mental Health Act.

Supporting up to 12 men, Cygnnet Lodge Kewstoke provides a high quality care through a collaborative, multi-disciplinary approach in a community facing environment. We focus on successful discharge planning from the moment individuals arrive. Service Users may have a range of mental health difficulties, including personality disorder or a mild learning disability (as a secondary diagnosis). Our approach focuses on a culture of risk management balanced with therapeutic optimism, where men have the opportunity to develop and practice skills they will need in a safe environment.

In addition to the rehabilitation service, we also provide a 15 bed male acute service, **Haywood ward**. This is a safe and stabilising environment for men experiencing an acute episode of mental illness and require emergency admission. Individuals may progress to The Lodge as a part of their care pathway from Haywood Ward to the community.

Our service user profile:

- > Men aged 18+ years
- > Detained under the Mental Health Act (1983) or informal
- > Primary diagnosis of mental illness with:
 - Complex comorbidities
 - Substance, drug and alcohol abuse
 - Treatment resistance
 - Behaviours that challenge
- > Aiming for a return to community or community-based care
- > Typical diagnoses: schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, bipolar affective disorder or depression
- > May have secondary diagnoses of mild learning disability, autism spectrum disorder or personality disorder
- > May have a forensic history and/or be stepping down from secure services
- > May have a history of repeated acute admissions

Our service at a glance

We offer a recovery-focused care pathway that involves getting to know the service user, identifying rehabilitation goals collaboratively with him, building and consolidating skills in order to prepare for community living. We take a multi-disciplinary approach with individualised timetables weekly for each individual to support progress along his care pathway.

The service offers a gym and therapy room on site with a Recovery College where individuals can take courses. We have input from creative therapies such as art, music and drama. There is a beach within walking distance and local shops and restaurants. There are expansive views from the lounge and upstairs bedrooms across the River. The nearest town is Weston-super-Mare, offering leisure activities and a chance to build community access skills. The surrounding Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty such as Quantock Hills, the Mendips and Cheddar Gorge open up even more options for therapeutic activities.

We pride ourselves on engagement with carers and families. We offer weekly contact within the Triangle of Care framework. We are centrally based for motorway access enabling ease of access for family, friends, carers and community teams to visit.


PICU/Acute Transitional Service

 - 4 Assessment pack formulated including care plans and funding information
 - 5 Admission agreed and plans for transition arranged with referring team following confirmation of acceptance of placement
